## Series B Power Lift Stackers

## Series M Walkie Stackers

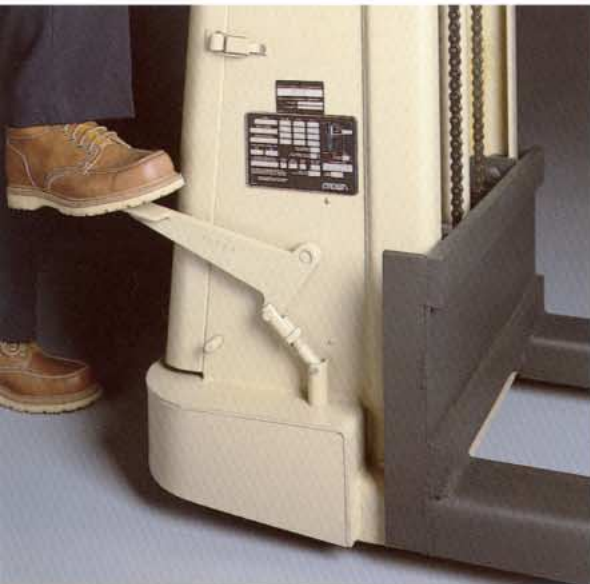


### Convenient Controls

Control levers on the Series B are conveniently arranged for the operator. A raise/lower lever allows a fixed lifting speed and variable lowering speeds for accurate positioning. And, there is a power disconnect lever that shuts off all battery power.

### Dual Lift Chains

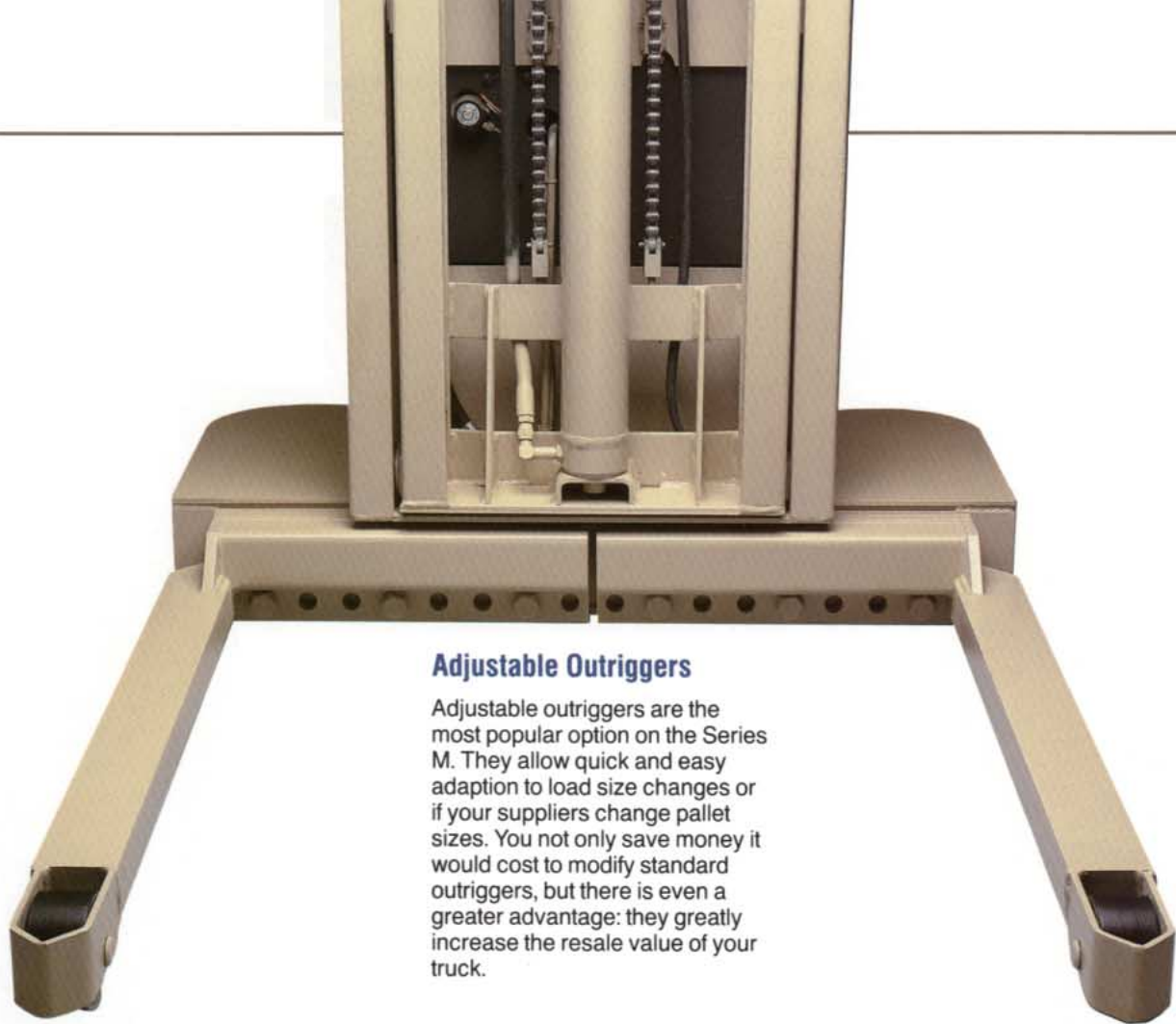
Unlike some competitive trucks, the Series B has dual lift chains. The ultimate strength of each chain is 7000 pounds. Also, an acrylic windshield provides excellent visibility yet keeps the operator separated from moving parts.



### Dual Floor Locks

Dual floor locks help keep the truck in a stationary position, utilizing two spring-loaded, flat rubber pads. Easy one-foot operation engages and disengages them.





### Adjustable Outriggers

Adjustable outriggers are the most popular option on the Series M. They allow quick and easy adaption to load size changes or if your suppliers change pallet sizes. You not only save money it would cost to modify standard outriggers, but there is even a greater advantage: they greatly increase the resale value of your truck.



### Most Imitated Control Handle

It's not difficult to understand why the Crown control handle is the most imitated in the world: it puts almost every function at the operator's fingertips.

Comfortable dual twist grips control forward and reverse travel. Buttons for raise and lower, and the horn are located in the middle of the handle for easy access at all times. A button at the end of the handle reverses the truck's travel direction should he come in contact with it. Also, there is a third-speed cutout switch that can be engaged when working in congested areas.
